### How to get to Birštonas?


### By car:

Birštonas is approximately 60-80 minutes south-west of Vilnius by car.

Look for A4/A16 directions from Vilnius and keep on A16 road which brings you straitght to Birštonas. Your destination is Vytautas Mineral SPA, Karalienės Barboros al. 2, Birštonas

#### **By Bus:**


Vilnius bus station is located at Sodų street 22, Vilnius. Intercity buses leave approximately 1-2 times every hour, the trip takes about 2-3 hours. Price ranges 7-10 euros per one direction trip. # Arriving at Vilnius University Hospital Santaros klinikos Department of Human and Medical Genetics

## **From city centre:**



Take bus 1G from bus stop "Vinco Kudirkos aikštė" (Gedimino pr. 11A) to bus stop "Santariškės". The trip takes about 25 minutes, depending on traffic.

## From the airport:

Take bus 3G from the airport bus stop to the "Žaliasis tiltas" bus stop (travel time is about 20 minutes, depending on traffic). Transfer to the bus 1G, ride to "Santariškės" bus stop (travel time is about 20min, depending on traffic).

When you arrive at Santariškės bus stop, cross the street. Medical Genetics Center is located on the 1st floor of the <u>F-Building</u> (Santariškių St. 2).
